Booking Fee

To secure the date and time of your ceremony, either full payment or a non-refundable booking fee of \$295 is required. If your date is secured with the non-refundable booking fee, the balance of the ceremony fee is to be paid no less than 30 days prior to the date of the ceremony.

Refund policy

The \$295 booking fee is non-refundable. If the ceremony has been paid for in full and notice of cancellation of the ceremony is provided no less than 60 days prior to the date of the ceremony, the ceremony fee less the non-refundable booking fee (\$295) will be refunded. If less than 60 days' notice of cancellation is provided the fee is non-refundable.

Inclusions

- A highly experienced and highly regarded Celebrant that is genuinely passionate and dedicated to creating and delivering the ceremony you envisage.
- Initial meeting with you both which includes a discussions of personalised ceremony options and ideas
- Completion of the marriage paperwork, lodgement of NOIM (Notice of Intended Marriage Form), sighting of identification.
- Ceremony tailored specifically for you and provided to you within 2 weeks of receiving your payment, for your review, input, edits and approval.
- Unlimited email support to ensure that all your questions are answered and that are super happy with your ceremony wording (*not applicable for 'legals only' bookings*)
- Use of premium high spec cordless PA system for delivery of ceremony and ceremony music if required (no power supply is required)
- Ceremony run sheet, a step by step run through detailing how you can expect the ceremony to flow on the day and a phone call the day before the wedding to reconfirm all the finer details.

- Your marriage documents sent to the QLD Marriage Registry and email notification of documents lodged.

Extras

- Travel Fee: There is no travel fee for ceremony locations within a 30km (direct line) radius of Brisbane's CBD. If over 30km from Brisbane CBD: A travel fee may apply, quoted upon request.
- Rehearsal if required: \$75 Note: Rehearsals are only available on weekends and week day evenings and by prior appointment. A travel fee may also apply.

PLEASE NOTE

- (1) Your ceremony date and time is secured only on receipt of your non-refundable booking fee or full payment.
- (2) Fees are subject to change. Fee changes do not apply to clients who have paid their booking fee or fee in full.
- (3) Music during the ceremony is your responsibility. For your convenience you are welcome to utilise our PA system which is iPod, CD and MP3 and smart phone compatible. Prior to the day, you must advise us if you require use of the PA system for ceremony music and arrange for someone (e.g. a guest) to be in charge of the music
- (4) If full payment is not received by 30 days prior to the ceremony date, Brisbane City Celebrants reserve the right to withdraw from their obligation to perform the ceremony.
- (5) Initial meeting and sighting of ID takes place within Brisbane, unless otherwise agreed.
